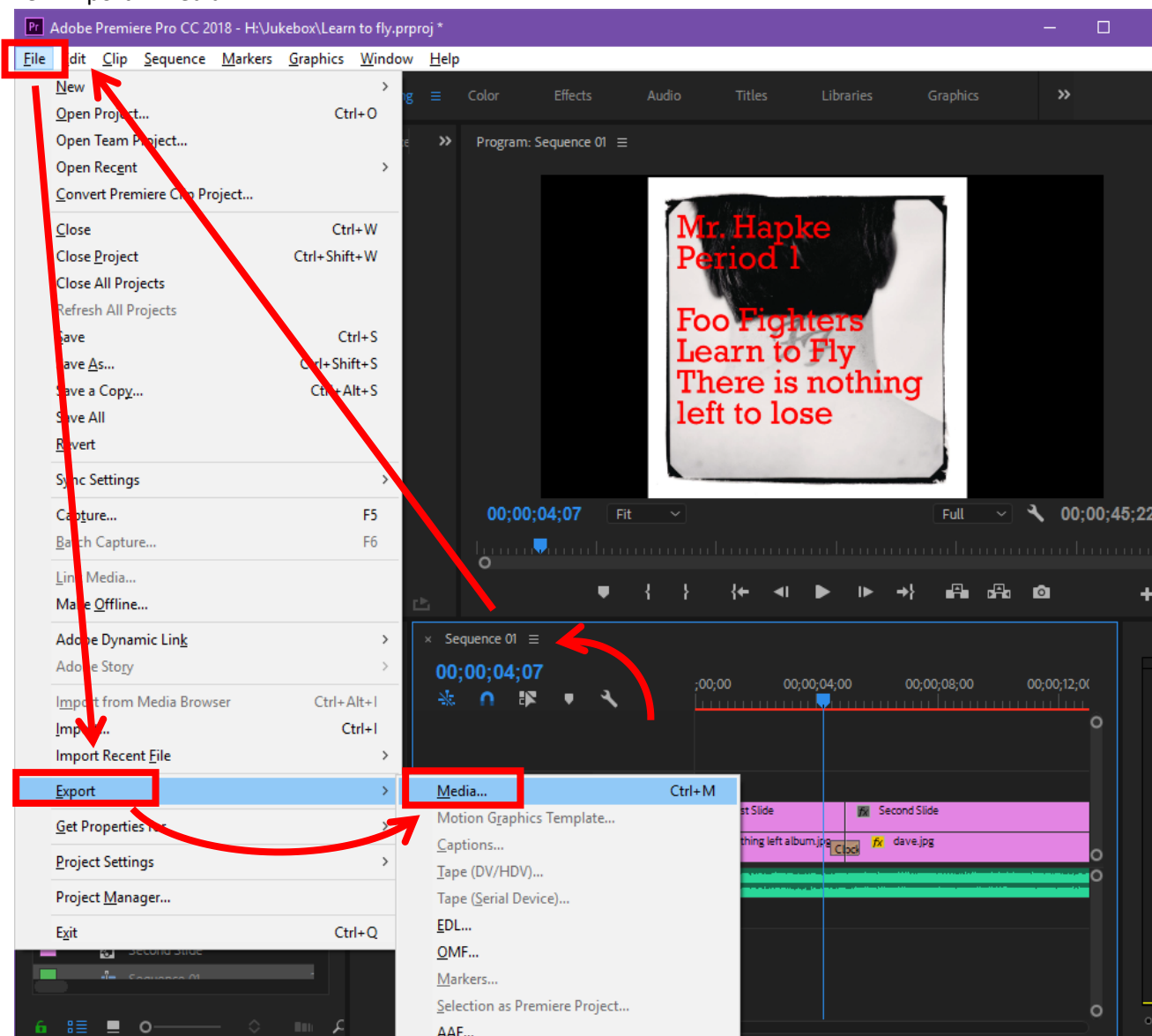


Exporting Your Movie File

1. Click in the Timeline / Sequence panel (bottom right) to make it the active panel. Notice how the panel has a [blue outline](#)!
2. File – Export – Media...



In the Export Media Pop-up

1. At the Bottom-Left → Source Range: **Entire Sequence** (whichever **Entire** ____ you can find! 😊)
2. Format: **H.264** (Not *H.264* *Bluray*... just the regular one.)
3. Preset: **Match Source - High Bitrate**
4. Click on the Output Name (in blue). This brings up the Save As box. Go to **My Documents**, and then your **Jukebox** folder. Name your file. (For the Jukebox assignment, use: **YourName – Artist – Song**)
Make sure the type is on *Video Files (*.mp4)*
Click **Save**
5. Click the **Video** Tab.
Check that the video size is **Width: 1280** and **Height: 720**. (If not, you probably missed the H.264 setting in Step 2!)
6. **Export**. You should get a popup box, with a scrollbar. It takes a minute or two.
